- Among the exhibits you can see, among others, a visa to Hamburg, where he began to play even with Stuart Sutcliffe, mock album covers, yellow submarine.


St. Mathew Street-Cavern Pub

- At St . Mathew Street , of course, you don't miss The Cavern .
- Reopened in 1984 after the reconstruction, it is a replica of the place where the Beatles began their great career.
- Visiting the exhibition 'The Beatles Story', a nostalgic journey through the history of the Beatles. Also in the Albert Dock, there is a Mersey cultural exhibition tour in the Museum of Liverpool Life as well as Beatles original posters from the 60s and jukebox for the use of visitors.

• Visit the shop of The Beatles Shop Matthew Street, the world's largest collection of equipment for Beatles fans (mugs, T-shirts).


INTERNATIONAL BEATLEWEEK



- The childhood homes of John Lennon and Paul McCartney have been faithfully restored by the National Trust. You can see the bedroom in Aunt Mimi's house on Menlove Avenue where a young John Lennon first began writing music, and the McCartney family home, where early Beatles rehearsals were held

WORLD OF THE BEA



The Beatles (John Lennon, Paul McCartney, George Harrison and Ringo Starr) were an English rock band that formed in Liverpool. Their band became arguably the most successful act of the 20th century.

The Beatles contributed to music, film, literature, art, and fashion, made a continuous impact on popular culture and the lifestyle of several generations.

In just a couple of years from producing their first demo record in 1963 they became the most famous musical men on the planet.

Paul McCartney, John Lennon, George Harrison and Ringo Starr are still to this day part of a music legend that has transcended time and decades of changing fashions.




The Beatles break UD

The death of their manager, Brian Epstein, which took place on August 27th, heralded the beginning of the end of the Beatles. They were terrified, because they had no idea what to do in the new situation. The team was swept by the chaos, which was the main cause of conflicts. Inheritance of the Epstein divided them the most. Paul McCartney saw in his place his father in law - Lee Eastman, while the rest of the team

preferred the manager of the Rolling Stones - Allen Klein. George Harrison unsuccessfully tried to reconcile the warring musicians and encourage them to creative efforts. He invited Eric Clapton to the sessions for the White Album, and Billy Preston to endless sessions for the album "Let It Be". Ultimately, the mission to rescue Apple - The Beatles corporation — was entrusted to Allen Klein. The practical end of the band (September 1969 — the



departure of John Lennon) was hidden from the public opinion. The official date of dissolution shall be deemed to be April 10th 1970, when Paul McCartney publically announced his departure.




